A special meeting of the City Commission of the City of Tioga was called to order at 6:30 pm on July 6, 2026, at the Tioga City Hall, by the City Commission President Brett Rieniets.

New Business:

1. Williams County Canvassing Board Results:

Motion by Ralston to accept Williams County Canvassing Board results. Second by Dye. Roll Call: Ayes; Ralston, Normark, Iverson, Dye, Rieniets.

2. Election of Commission Vice President: Rieniets advised that a Vice President of the commission needs to be elected or re-elected. Jaden Iverson has been the Vice President and Rieniets shared his support of Iverson continuing to serve in that roll.

Motion by Ralston to appoint Jaden Iverson as commission vice president. Second by Dye. Roll Call: Ayes; Ralston, Normark, Iverson, Dye, Rieniets.

3. Assignment of Portfolio for Commission Members: Rieniets advised that they would go through each portfolio. Ralston expressed interest in staying in his role as street commissioner.

Motion by Iverson to assign Kyle Ralston as Street Commissioner. Second by Dye. Roll Call: Ayes; Ralston, Normark, Iverson, Dye, Rieniets. Jaden requested to keep his portfolio as finance commissioner.

Motion by Ralston to assign Jaden Iverson as Finance Commissioner. Second by Dye.

Roll Call: Ayes; Ralston, Normark, Iverson, Dye, Rieniets. Steven Dye and Cody Normark both expressed interest in serving as the police commissioner. **Motion by Ralston to assign Cody Normark to as Police Commissioner. Second by Normark. Roll Call: Ayes; Ralston, Normark, Iverson, Rieniets.**

Nayes: Dye. Rieniets advised that the last portfolio was the Water Commissioner. **Motion by Ralston to assign Steven Dye as Water Commissioner. Second by Normark. Roll Call: Ayes; Ralston, Normark, Iverson, Dye, Rieniets.**

4. Appointments: Rieniets advised that the commission would appoint City officials beginning with the City Auditor. **Motion by Ralston to appoint Wendy Lenzen as the City Auditor. Second by Iverson.**

Roll Call: Ayes; Ralston, Normark, Iverson, Dye, Rieniets. Rieniets asked for an appointment for City Attorney and shared that Liz Pendlay is the current attorney and would like to see her in that position.

Motion by Ralston to appoint Liz Pendlay as the City Attorney. Second by Normark. Roll Call: Ayes; Ralston, Normark, Iverson, Dye, Rieniets.

Motion by Ralston to adjourn with no further business at 6:38 PM. Second by Dye. Roll Call: Ayes; Ralston, Iverson, Normark, Dye, Rieniets.
