Tioga Fund Advisory Board Minutes

Call to Order: A meeting of the Tioga Fund Advisory Board of the City of Tioga was called to order at 6:00 pm on Tuesday, July 14, 2026 at the Tioga City Hall by President of the Tioga Fund Advisory Board Myles Rosencrans.

Lenzen made a motion to approve the minutes of June 9, 2026; second by Alberts.

Old Business: Discussion was held on allocating the previously approved funds to the Tioga Historical Society contingent on securing matching funds. \$121,000 was approved on March 12, 2026, but no funds were designated in the motion.

Pederson made a motion to take half from Economic Development fund, \$60,500, and half from Community Improvement, \$60,500; second by Germundson.

New Business:

1. Tioga Police Department – Community Improvement

The police department is asking for \$2,668 to pay for a rock climbing wall for National Night Out on August 4th.

Pederson made a motion to approve the request for \$2,668.00, second by Alberts, to come from Community Improvement portion.

2. Tioga American Legion Post #139 – Community Improvement

Scott Post and RC Neset presented an application to help fund the new Legion building project. They have received \$500,000 from a Williams County Grant, some other funding from grants and donations. They have \$1.3 million and have another fundraiser planned. They are requesting \$250,000 from Tioga Fund.

Pederson made a motion to approve the request for \$250,000.00, with 50% (\$125,000) to come from Economic Development, 25% (\$62,500) from Recreation, and 25% (\$62,500) from Community Improvement; second by Lenzen

3. Northwest Sportsmans Association – Community Improvement

Nate Raan, Keri Schaffer, and Layne Ferguson presented an application to request more funding for the gun range improvements. Due to inexperience of volunteers doing a project of this size, the engineering fees were not included in the last application, and a slight change of plans due to more interest, leaving a funding gap of \$65,000. Another \$16,000

is requested to add a 3rd trap field now rather than waiting, incurring more costs later. Another school has requested to use the range as their home range. Current grant opportunities do not allow expenditures until 2027, while they want the range to be open and up to spec in March for the 2027 spring season.

Lenzen made a motion to approve the request for \$81,000.00, with 50% (\$40,500) to come from Recreation, and 50% (\$40,500) from Community Improvement; second by Alberts.

4. City of Tioga – Community Improvement

Dan Larson and Dustin Taylor presented an application to revive the soccer field project previously approved in 2021. They were granted \$126,009.80 and bought a shed for storage and paid for a grading plan, leaving a balance of \$85,151.80. They supplied an updated total of \$205,729.00, of which they are requesting half from the Tioga Fund, but also considering the old funds. Discussion was had about what was done previously, donated materials and what was needed to get started. Discussion was had on moving forward with the old funds on just getting the field started and seeing what they can get from Williams County in August.

Alberts motioned to table the application; second by Pederson.
